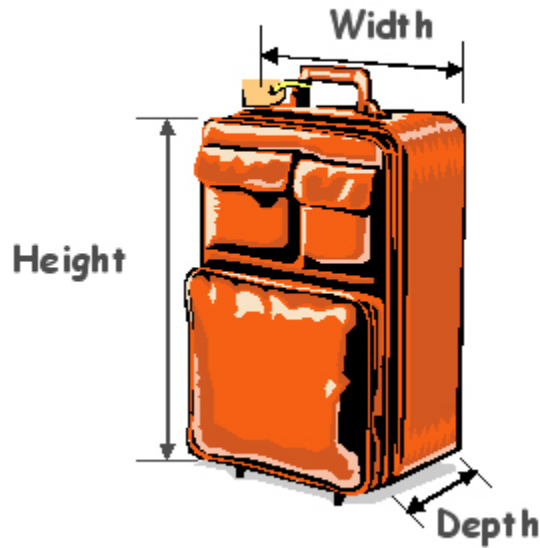


## LUGGAGE / BAGGAGE POLICY

Our Mission is to deliver the best value in air medical transportation, while not compromising patient care. In order to achieve this mission, most of the space normally available for luggage in charter airplanes is now occupied with medical equipment and supplies. It has been our experience that passenger luggage can result in departure delays. Therefore only one piece of luggage per person as indicated below will be allowed on flights arranged by AMR Air Ambulance.

Dimensions in centimeters 40 Wide x 26 Deep x 46 Tall



We apologize if this causes any inconvenience; however please remember that our primary concern is for the patient's wellbeing. In order to avoid delays in the patient transport, all arrangements for shipping of additional luggage must be made prior to the time departure. Any items brought aboard are subject to search by a member of the Part 135 air carrier's flight crew, TSA personnel or Customs officers. All items transported must be in compliance with the Official Customs and Immigration Policies of the countries involved. All firearms are prohibited. Items that are not allowed on commercial airline flights are prohibited on flights arranged by AMR Air Ambulance.

AMR Air Ambulance is an indirect air carrier which arranges and coordinates air ambulance services. All flights are operated by direct air carriers holding certificates issued under 14 C.F.R. Part 121 or 135.
